

OPTIONAL: Extra information

To be "born again" is not something that we can do for ourselves like being baptized or deciding to "do better." It is not the same thing as "turning over a new leaf."

All of us have been **born physically** into the human family (born of water).

We need to be **born again spiritually** (born of the Spirit) into God's family.

DON'T DESPAIR! THERE IS HOPE FOR SINNERS! WE MAY BE BORN AGAIN!

Romans 8:14-17 says "... As many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together."

That Scripture passage tells us that Holy Spirit of God did a work in our heart that helped us to see our need for salvation. When we were saved, we were born and adopted into God's family. Now we are the children of God, having all of the benefits of that birth and adoption. What a privilege! It is amazing to see how much God loves us!

Read **Romans 8:31-39**. According to these verses, when will God stop loving those who have trusted in Jesus Christ for salvation?

 Have you believed on and called upon the name of the Lord?
If you have, then you can have great confidence that you have been "born again" and adopted into God's family. You are a Christian.

One of the biggest struggles new Christians have is that of fearing that they will do something that will cause them to lose their salvation.

- Read John 10:27-30 "My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand. I and my Father are one."
- When will those who follow the Good Shepherd perish according to these verses?

Carefully read John 1:1-5 & 9-14

In this passage, Jesus is called "The Word". (Notice that **John 1:14** describes The Word as "the only begotten of the Father.")

- Where was The Word in the beginning of time? (Read **John 1:1-2**)
- What does **John 1:3** say that The Word was doing with God in the beginning?

- So, where is the source of all life? (Read **John 1:4**)
- Another name for Jesus is "The Light" (See John 1:9). So, "The Light" came into the world that He created. Was "The Light" quickly accepted? (See John 1:10-11)
- Not everybody was willing to receive "The Light." But what is promised to all who receive "The Light?" (Read **John 1:12**)

• John 1:13 describes the new birth that takes place when a person believes on the name of the Lord Jesus Christ. Is this another physical birth, or is this a spiritual birth? (Read **John 1:13**)

 Do you understand that Jesus Christ is "The Light of the World," and the manifestation of "The Word of God" – that Jesus is God Himself? (Read John 1:14)

DO YOU KNOW WHY DID GOD SENT HIS "ONLY BEGOTTEN SON" (JESUS CHRIST) INTO THE WORLD?

Read Luke 19:10 "...The Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost."

The "Son of Man" describes the transformation that took place when God the Son came to earth and became a man.

- Not only did God love the world, His "only begotten Son" also loved the world! (Read Romans 5:6-9)
- What did God's "only begotten Son" do for all the ungodly sinners in this world?

JESUS CHRIST WAS OUR SUBSTITUTE. HE DIED IN OUR PLACE

• Why did the world need to be "saved"?

The Death of Jesus Christ satisfied God's wrath on man's disobedience.

•	Whose sins were paid for through the death of Jesus Christ? (Read I John 2:1-2)

Propitiation – The quick and easy understanding of this word is the idea of someone saying, "I've got you covered" – meaning "I've paid the bill." The cost of our sin (death) has been paid in full through Christ's death on the cross.

"The word means 'appeasement' or 'satisfaction.' The sacrifice of Jesus on the cross satisfied the demands of God's holiness for the punishment of sin."

John MacArthur, The MacArthur Study Bible (Wheaton, IL: Crossway, 2010).

While the death of Jesus Christ was sufficient to cover the sins of the whole world, only those who are born again can enjoy the benefit of His sacrifice.

WE CAN BE COMPLETELY CERTAIN THAT WE HAVE BEEN BORN AGAIN!

The best way to get assurance (certainty) that you have been born again is to Read the Bible for yourself. Jesus Himself said in John 5:39 "Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of Me."
